Spotlight Speaker was introduced by Anthony

- Tatyana Kelly Facing Helene Understanding the All-Hazards
  - Tatyana explained that there is still an on-going recovery in North Carolina post-Helene
  - Tatyana reviewed the Timeline of events during Hurricane Helene
    - Sept 23, 2024 Storm forms in the western Caribbean
    - Sept 25, 2024
      - Enhanced watch
      - Started looking at SMSS Locatinos
      - Polled for NC EMS Resources
      - Check-ins with Statewide Patient Coordination Team
    - Sept 26
      - State OCS Full activation
      - Resources on the ground
      - Power outages and flooding
    - Sept 27
      - EMS Resource requests hit
      - SMSS site approved
      - Acute Care contacts contacted via phone
      - Home Depot, Lowes assistance activated
    - Sept 28
      - 95 resources requested
      - Standups facilites activated

- Internet, VOIP lost, power out
- VIPER Systems helped a lot
- Started healthcare assessments which were questions for facilities to answer regarding the status of their facility and it's needs
- Roads washed out
- OEM deployed Helicopters that were sent to investigate remote facilities
- Sept 29
  - Requested SEOC Support
  - Public Health Emergency Declared
  - Federal Ambulances deployed
- Sept 30
  - Sat phones used for communication
  - Diverting traffic from western half of state
  - Road access was still an issue
  - 9 Days to get to a nursing facility ; needed horses
- Requests
  - 7659 total WebEOC Requests
  - Average 30 -50 per day
- Points of emphasis
  - Western NC is rural and hilly
  - Wells without electricity will become unhealthy due to contamination (ecoli)
  - Communication cell phone towers become compromised
  - Drones were used to drop supplies
  - Health care assessment questionnaires were developed to determine resilience (supplies, utility availability, utility capacities)
  - What would be done differently, coalition reach out to tighten communications/connections. Patient transport to hospital issues.
