Weather/hazard forecasts: Per the National Weather Service (NWS) no adverse weather events have been noted as of 1000 Hours (04/23/2025).

Critical infrastructure impacts: As noted above, thousands of residential and commercial structures are presently threatened.

Jersey Central Power and Light (JCP&L/JCPL) as of 1800 Hours (04/22/2025) has intentionally de-energized lines originating from the Oyster Creek substation at the request of the NJFFS to ensure firefighter safety. Crews will be working around the clock to restore power when possible. At this time, approximately 25,000 residents are impacted by this utility cut.

Population evacuation statistics: Residential (non-healthcare stakeholder communities) have undergone mandatory and voluntary evacuations with shelters being established at two (2) local area high schools
